Setting:

Objective:

Observe and learn how some followers of Jesus go about evangelizing, discipling unchurched people, and planting churches to become better equipped for church planting in other towns or countries.

Expectations:

Interns will assist in the logistical and inspirational needs of the PSU campus organization, *Happy Valley Christian Community*. This campus organization offers ESL classes, Bible studies, cultural events, apologetic classes, and other ministries to international students and their families.

Interns will attend any ministry or outreach activities that the Eby family is involved in and will assist with logistics. They will attempt to recruit students for Bible studies and help with church planting work in Centre County. In exchange for the mentoring that interns receive, they will help with work at the ABT property, *Plain News*, community garden, and other local initiatives.

Interns could apply for work at *All Nations Bible Translation*, *Sowers' Harvest Café*, *Hess Construction*, or some other local business. Interns must seek employment that allows for schedule flexibility, freedom from stress, and freedom from responsibility outside of work hours. Interns could also operate their own business if it did not interfere with FOJ beliefs and values. Any business opportunities must not distract them from their main purpose for being here, that of evangelism, discipleship, and church planting in the State College area.
